

Grading of Arts Schools

Marking Scheme

1. Grading is done as follows

- i. General Grade
- ii. Best Grade
- iii. Super Grade

2. Method of giving marks

Buildings, Office and other facilities

- Temporarily erected thatched hut - 05 marks
- Hall without an enclosure with a tiled roof - 10 marks
- Hall with ventilation, cemented floor and a tiled roof - 14 marks
- Fully fledged theatre hall with Air conditioned facility - 15 marks

(marks should be from minimum of 05 to 15)

1. Equipment (Musical etc.)

- In case the number of equipment including musical equipment, drums and other are less than 10, 10 marks will be given. Two marks will be given for each additional equipment.(It is mandatory to submit the list of equipment)

(Minimum marks 10 to maximum 20)

II. Number of Students

- The minimum number of the students will be decided by the constitution of the Arts Institution. (20 students). 10 marks will be given to the minimum number of students. If there are 5 students beyond the minimum, 01 mark each will be added. (Register of Students should be submitted)

(20 maximum marks)

III. Staff

- Five marks each for each teacher.

(Minimum marks 10 to maximum 20)

IV. Number of hours of the classes conducted

- 10 minimum hours per week (if the classes are conducted for 40 hours per month 10 marks will be given. One mark will be given for every additional hour.)

(20 maximum marks)

V. Exam Results/ Status of the students

- Two marks will be given to each student who has passed the examination of Kalayathana (Copies of Certificates should be submitted for proof)

(30 maximum marks)
